The structure and procedure of Community Care Policy for frail elderly people in Britain have developed care management system. In care management care assessment has very important roles. This is almost the same even if the patient is a schizophrenic.

For the sake of this approach, I think clinical psychologists are the most suitable. I consider this reason, too, in this paper.

And I make a proposal to support clinical psychologists.
